

# What Does Preparation for **EU CSDDD** Look Like in Practice?



## STEPS

- 1 Review existing policies, due diligence processes, and grievance mechanisms** to assess alignment with global sustainability due diligence frameworks and gaps against CSDDD provisions; conduct preliminary assessment of actual and potential impacts.
- 2 Engage your Board of Directors on CSDDD** and sustainability due diligence more broadly and brief them on relevant human rights and environmental issues.
- 3 Build internal capacity** on sustainability due diligence across functions and foster collaboration on the interconnected aspects of human rights and environmental impacts.
- 4 Map your value chain**, identify and strategize on how to engage affected stakeholders, and evaluate peer or multi-stakeholder initiatives that support your company's due diligence journey.
- 5 Develop and implement a roadmap** for complying with the CSDDD that includes ambitious climate targets and key milestones for mapping your due diligence landscape, consulting with stakeholders, and addressing due diligence gaps.
